1. Call to Order

Chair Ron Foggin called the meeting to order at 10:00am.

2. Roll Call

Tommy Martin performed roll call. Present: Chair Ron Foggin, Vice Chair Steve Latoski, Members: Jeff Thuneman, Will Randolph, Roland Hulse, Jess Knudson, Todd Steinberger, Matt Gunderson (for Scott Holtry)

3. Title VI – Notice to the Public

Tommy Martin read the Title VI notice to the public.

4. Call to the Public

Chair Ron Foggin made a call to the public. No public comment.

5. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve the TAC Meeting Minutes of March 24, 2026

Roland Hulse motioned to approve the March 24, 2026, meeting minutes. Jeff Thuneman seconded. Approved.

6. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve the FY 2027-FY 2031 Transportation Improvement Program Amendment #1 – 5310 Awards

Sarah Lojewski presented the 5310 Transit amendments to be listed in the LHMPO TIP. The 4 projects have no impact on LHMPO fiscal constraint or other regional funding. The projects added are for Capital Preventative Maintenance, Operating funds and Mobility Management. The 5310 projects are for Rise, WACOG, New Horizons, and AZ Board of Regents.

Jeff Thuneman motioned to approve the FY 2027-2031 TIP Amendment for 5310 awards. Roland Hulse seconded. Approved.

7. Discussion and Possible Action to Approve the FY 2027 RTAC Priority Projects

Sarah Lojewski presented the FY2027 RTAC Priority Project List. The 7 projects presented included the Intersections Improvement Study, Multi-Use Trail Landscaping and Effluent Irrigation, Kiowa

Boulevard Improvements, Safe Routes to School Improvements, McCulloch Blvd & Beachcomber Blvd, Retroreflective Signal Backplates, and Pavement Preservation.

Jeff Thuneman motioned to approve the FY2027 RTAC Priority Project list as presented. Jess Knudson seconded. Approved.

8. Regional Transportation Plan – Update and Draft RTP Document Tour

Chris Johannes and Kristen Faltz from Kimley-Horn presented an update on the Draft RTP.

9. LHMPO Report – Project and Studies Update

Tommy Martin provided an update on LHMPO and regional projects including: Safe Routes to School Study, TA applications, HSIP projects in design and construction, CRP project out for construction bids (multi-use path upgrades), and LHC HURF exchange projects currently in design and construction.

10. Discussion and Updates of ADOT Northwest District Regional Projects

Todd Steinberger provided an update on the West Kingman Traffic Interchange Project, Maintenance Litter Contract, new HSIP project on SR 95 north of City limits (passing lane). Chair Ron Foggin asked for update on the I-40/SR 95 interchange bridge project and the selection of a new ADOT District Administrator. Mr. Steinberger provided a schedule update on the bridge project (under design with construction start in late FY27). Mr. Steinberger informed the TAC that the District Administrator role has been filled.

11. Discussion of the Current ADOT Programs and Events

Will Randolph provided updates on the 5-year construction program and upcoming steps for the next annual review cycle of FY28-32. Mr. Randolph informed the TAC of the selection of a new P2P manager to replace Jason James. Mr. Randolph provided an update on the ADOT 2055 Long Range Transportation Plan, Transportation alternative program awards, ADOT Route Transfer Study, State Freight Plan, and ADOT COG/MPO manual update.

12. Discussion of Projects, Studies, & Events in Mohave County

Roland Hulse had no updates for WACOG.
