#### 7. 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Update

Vinny Gallegos, LHMPO Director introduces Phyllis Davis, Kittelson & Associates to the TAC for the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan update for the future of highways, roads and safety. Phyllis Davis & Associates presented a PowerPoint to identify projects from their future condition assessment. The PowerPoint covered existing and future conditions of traffic congestion, and safety concerns.

Steven Latoski expressed his concern of the crashes on SR95 corridor and the fatal rates are what should be carried in the conversation rather than the whole numbers.

Jess Knudson expressed his concern on the Mulberry/SR95 traffic signals and how he would like that to be considered as a safety issue and project for the future. Mr. Knudson added there is a lack of right-a-way on roadways and unfortunately there is no room to add an extra lane and how this should be expressed to the public.

Greg Froslie explained he would support the two hundred thousand to be used for the state match funds and the remaining funds be used for the traffic signal technology for SR95/ Lake Havasu Ave.

#### 8. Discuss Draft of the FY2022 & 2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)

Vinny Gallegos, LHMPO Director presented a visual document of the FY 22-23 draft UPWP changes and updates. Mr. Gallegos explained the different funding's the LHMPO receives yearly and how the funds are spend throughout the fiscal year.

The TAC gave a unanimous decision to take the draft UPWP to the executive board for approval.

#### 9. Discuss Draft FY22-FY26 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Vinny Gallegos, LHMPO Director explained to the TAC the TIP amendment changes and updates. He stated the TIP has not been recreated it is the same existing TIP however, had been amended. Mr. Gallegos explained the TIP has funds that need to be reprogramed and has expressed potential projects to reprogram the funds too.

Phyllis Davis, Kittelson project manager presented the RTP recommendations to use to reprogram the TIP funds.

Justin Hembree, WACOG Transportation Manager shared with the TAC the WACOG's STBG funds and how they are used. Mr. Hembree explains programmed projects for studies and how the studies have been shown to make a large impact on the returns on the investments for planning documents instead of infrastructure.
