7. Highway Safety Improvement (HSIP) Discussion

Michael Blankenship, Greenlight Traffic Engineering explained to the TAC that with HISP
projects, they can only be used for fatal and serious injuries for HSIP projects. Mr. Blankenship
presented to the TAC a crash data analyst report showing fatal crash data in Lake Havasu City
Area. Mr. Blankenship introduces an interactive crash data map of Lake Havasu City showing

where fatal and serious injuries have occurs. He gave a visual of the problematic areas and address possible ideas to consider for HSIP projects.

Mr. Latoski presented a request for a road widening in Horizon six to consider as a HSIP project. Mr. Latoski also suggested street striping for a lesser construction cost.

Mr. Blankenship explained the project would not meet the threshold due to the low crash ratings.

Mr. Froslic responded that the greater need for HSIP applications would be SR95, downtown corridor and Acoma corridor. If there is a possibility to add the unincorporated areas. We can look at doing a joint project.

Mr. Hembree introduce several projects ideas such as curbs, and striping that could collectively be large enough to be approved for an application.
