8. FY25-26 HSIP Application update

Justin Hembree, LHMPO Director updated the TAC on the 5 HSIP applications that Greenlight Engineer created and will submit after ADOT and the local agencies review. The following is a list of the Lake Havasu MPO HSIP project applications for FY25-26.

1. State Route 95 - Raised Median: \$4 Million

- S. Palo Verde to Industrial Blvd (0.8 miles),
- N. Palo Verde to North of Chenoweth (2.2 miles),
- S. Acoma to Oro Grande (1.0 miles)

2. Swanson Ave Intersections (Wing Loop, Mariposa Dr., and Wing Loop): \$250k

- Rectangular Rapid Flash Beacons, High Visibility Crosswalks

3. Horizon 6 – Gold Springs Rd, Blue Canyon Rd: \$250k

- Widen 3 Feet, Restripe for 10' Lanes

4. Traffic Signal Warrant Study: \$200k

Signal Warrant Study – LHMPO Planning Study based on the recommendations of the 2045 long-range plan.

Non-Signalized Intersections:

- Palo Verde N / Lake Havasu Ave – 2 Serious
- Kiowa Blvd / Lake Havasu Ave – 1 Serious
- W Acoma Blvd / Lake Havasu Ave – 3 Serious
- Swanson / Acoma - Pending ADOTs approval to switch improvements to McCulloch /Jamaica
- Swanson Ave / Smoketree Ave – 1 Serious
- Mesquite Ave / Smoketree Ave – 1 Serious
- Mesquite Ave / Riviera Blvd – 4 Serious
- Smoketree Ave / Acoma Blvd – 2 Serious
- Maricopa Ave / Oro Grande Blvd – 2 Serious
- Maricopa Ave (Fremont Dr.) / Acoma Blvd S – 1 Serious

William Randolph, Regional Transportation Planner updated the TAC on the following:

- The tentative Five-Year Transportation Facilities Construction Program is available for public review and comment until June 2nd. Public comment may be presented at the upcoming State Transportation Board meeting being held on May 20th. Any public comments may also be submitted through the online portal at the following location:

- HSIP draft applications are due to ADOT by MAY 31st, ADOT comments will be returned to the applicants by June 30th with the final applications due to ADOT being August 2nd.
- The deadline for MEGA, INFRA or Rural grant applications is May 23rd.
- deadline for NSBP grant applications has been extended to June 20th.
- A webinar will be held on Thursday May 19th to discuss the U.S.D.O.T. Reconnecting Communities Pilot discretionary grant program.
- The notice to proceed for the Long Range Transportation Plan is anticipated to be released by the end of May.
- Data collection efforts for the Statewide rest area study are almost complete. The draft working paper is currently being reviewed by the TAC.
- The potential stakeholder meeting for the Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Plan is scheduled to be held in June.

Roland Hulse, WACOG Transportation Manager, stated the WACOG Transportation Implementation Plan is proceeding as planned following the financial Analysis phase which should be concluded in June.
