6. Lake Havasu MPO Manager's Introduction and Discussion

Justin Hembree, New LHMPO Manager introduced himself to the TAC and explained his background with WACOG and the interaction he had as a Lake Havasu TAC member. TAC members welcomed Justin to his new position.

7. Highway Safety Improvement (HSIP) Discussion

Michael Blankenship, with Greenlight Traffic Engineering, presented the TAC with potential HISP projects to consider for the FY25-26 call-for-projects. Mr. Blankenship explained the applications can only use fatal and serious injury crashes to calculate B/C ratios. Mr. Blankenship recommended projects with a B/C ratio of 10 or higher be considered, however, he noted that ADOT allows for a minimum B/C ratio of 2.5. Tentatively, the top projects for consideration are Swanson, McCulloch, and the intersection at SR95 & Food City.

8. 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) Update

Phyllis Davis, Kittelson & Associates Project Manager updated the TAC with upcoming events for the RTP and shared an updated timeline. Ms. Davis provided the TAC with a flyer and links to the RTP public survey. She requested that TAC members personally fill out the public survey as well as distribute it to other's who may be interested. Ms. Davis also discussed the need to schedule one-on-one meetings with TAC members in the near future, to discuss projects of importance and to aid in the project prioritization process of the Regional Transportation Plan.

9. Call for Legislative Set-Aside Projects (2022 Session) - Discussion

Justin Hembree, LHMPO Manager announced the official call for 2022 legislative set-aside/earmarked projects. Mr. Hembree discussed the project applications, project prioritization, submittal timeline, and the newly created section of the LHMPO TIP. Based on the table and figures provided by the Rural Transportation Advocacy Council (RTAC) the overall anticipated funding available to the LHMPO region is estimated at \$1,633,292. LHMPO member agency project requests and applications for the anticipated funding of the 2022 Arizona legislative session are due to LHMPO by July 31 (the last day of July), 2021. Projects will be reviewed & ranked by the TAC at their regular scheduled meeting on August 24, 2021.
